Stop Blood Thinners such as: Clopidogrel (Plavix), Aggrenox, Ticlid, Pradaxa. Stop Iron supplements. Stop Fiber supplements and foods that contain skins, seeds or nuts. Examples: Tomatoes, cucumbers, poppy or chia seeds, popcorn, wheat breads. Arrange a ride. You will be sedated for this procedure & must have an escort to drive you home or the procedure will be cancelled. Taxi cab or public transportation is not allowed.	Carefully review the upcoming prep instructions for the next 2 days. Purchase NuLytely prep at the pharmacy. Stop - Blood thinners such as: Coumadin, Warfarin. Stop - Anti-inflammatory medications: Motrin, Advil and Ibuprofen. You may take Tylenol. Stop - Aspirin only if you are taking it for arthritis or as a general recommendation. Do NOT stop Aspirin if you have a history of heart disease, TIA, stroke or blood clots.	Drink 8 glasses of clear liquids throughout the day to stay hydrated. You may continue on a Low Fiber Diet until 5:00 PM. If you are Diabetic you may need to adjust your medication prior to the procedure. Check with your prescribing doctor. 5:00 PM Take 2 Bisacodyl tablets. Drink one 10 oz. bottle of Magnesium Citrate. (Magnesium Citrate is in the laxative section of your pharmacy. No prescription is needed.) Begin Clear Liquid Diet See handout.	Clear Liquid Diet NO SOLID FOODS 12:00 PM Take 2 Bisacodyl tablets. Drink one 10 oz. bottle of Magnesium Citrate. 5:00 - 7:00 PM Begin drinking the NuLytely prep. Drink one 8oz glass every 15-30 minutes until half of the solution is gone. Continue to drink clear liquids. Do not consume low calorie beverages.	Take your regularly scheduled heart, blood pressure or seizure medications. Atresume drinking all of the remaining prep solution. The final results should be clear yellow or green resembling chicken broth or lemonade with no solid stool. Continue to drink clear liquids until Nothing by mouth 4 hours prior to your procedure time. Be sure to bring: ✓ Co-pay/Deductable ✓ Insurance Card ✓ ID/Driver License
Just a reminder: On your procedure day you will not be able to work, drive, operate equipment, sign any important papers, drink alcohol or take sedatives for the remainder of that day. No out of town travel to a remote area or on a cruise ship for 1 week if polyps are removed.
